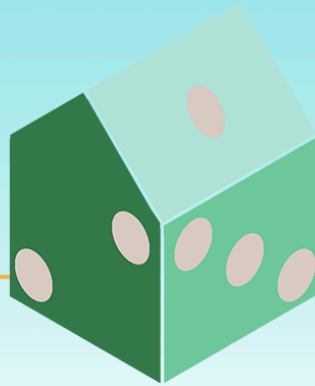

Meta information and statistics per country (for all years) as CSV and XML formatted files, as well as the raw measurement data as ASCII formatted files ([see note](#)).

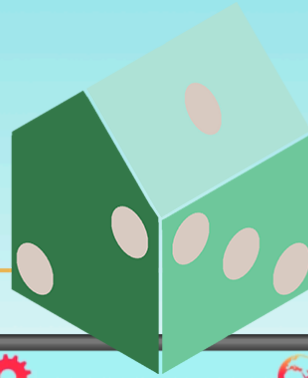
